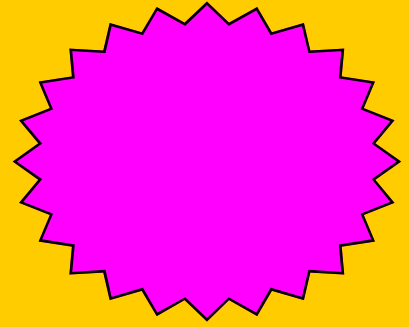


Eddie Moore
