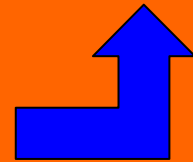
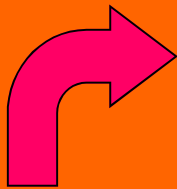


# Frank Naisbitt Of Class 2008
